INTRODUCTION:

The Indian Pharmaceutical and Chemical Industry today is in the front rank of India's science based industries with wide ranging capabilities in the complex field of manufacture and technology. Number of pharmaceutical industries are located in Andhra Pradesh especially in and around Visakhapatnam. Solvent Management is one of the key performance indicators in the environment and safety compliance. There were instances of industrial accidents while handling the solvents causing concern to the stakeholders.

The industry uses a number of solvents and in large quantities the manufacturing processes. Good Practices in solvent management will result in improved environmental and safety compliance. Applying good techniques can lead to less consumption of resources lower emissions of VOC gases and reduced generation of hazardous wastage. Solvent Management System is a structured way of working to reduce solvent consumption and emissions.

REGULATIONS:

Recognizing the environmental impacts due to solvents, AP Pollution Control Board stipulates conditions through Consent & Hazardous Waste Management for compliance by the industry for handling the solvents. Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, stipulates certain specific compliance requirements for handling and disposing the solvent waste. Similarly, the Department of Factories stipulates conditions for safety compliance.

- ◆ Sharing the industry experience and practices in the solvent management
