Webinar on “Compliance of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 with focus on COVID 19 waste management”

Objective: To sensitize and update the stakeholders on BMW Rules, compliance requirements and with specific focus on CPCB guidelines to handle the COVID-19 waste.

Description: HCFs generate “Bio-Medical Waste”, which needs to be handled carefully during collection to treatment and final disposal. Recognizing the need to regulate the BMW, Government of India brought specific regulations known as “**Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016**” and its amendments. Also, National Green Tribunal while reviewing petitions related to BMW rules for compliance issued certain directions.

CoVID -19 Waste Management: Recognizing the need to handle the Bio-medical waste in the present pandemic situation, Central Pollution Control Board has issued certain specific guidelines and with responsibilities for different stakeholders.
